Membership and Culture

- This year we had a very successful sign-in, welcoming 143 new Sophomores to our Terrace Family, as well as an additional 23 new Upperclassmen members.
- Terrace has continued to be an exciting and desirable venue for large-scale music events, including a recent performance by the Grammy-winning band Snarky Puppy.
- Every Friday, we have a members-only events night. Events this semester have included film screenings by the Terrace Film Club, fine beer, cocktail nights, etc.
- Sunday – Wednesday we have been offering a fourth meal that starts at 10:30pm and ends around midnight. This has proved to be a great way to get rid of leftovers (though we do not exclusively use leftovers for these meals.)

Sustainability and (Food=Love)

- We have reusable plastic cups for tap nights, which are washed and redistributed by officers and members on duty (1 member duty required per year).
- Our head chef purchases from a number of local food sources whenever possible and provides extra-delicious vegetarian and vegan options at every meal. The main courses often include delicacies such as lamb, roast chicken, flank-steak, calamari, clams, tilapia, etc.
- Our kitchen composts all of our pre-production food scraps in the backyard.

Technology and House Renovations (Summer Projects, and Continuing)

- A new sound system has been installed for the entranceway. A comprehensive speaker system has been installed in the main and lower dining room.
- We have renovated the Green Room and Computer Room on the second floor, creating an extra hallway and an office for our Club Manager. This new arrangement provides a more convenient and appealing layout for both members and visitors.
- Other improvements
 - We repainted the Servery, Dining room, and Solarium and Computer room.
 - We have placed hammocks in the back and front yards.
 - We have put in new carpeting in the Willard room and bought 6 new couches.
 - We have put new carpeting in the TV room
 - We now have speakers in every room of the house.
- Future Projects:
 - Many more improvements are planned for the summer of 2014, especially the reconstruction of the terrace deck which leaks badly.
