TECHNOLOGY & MEDIA

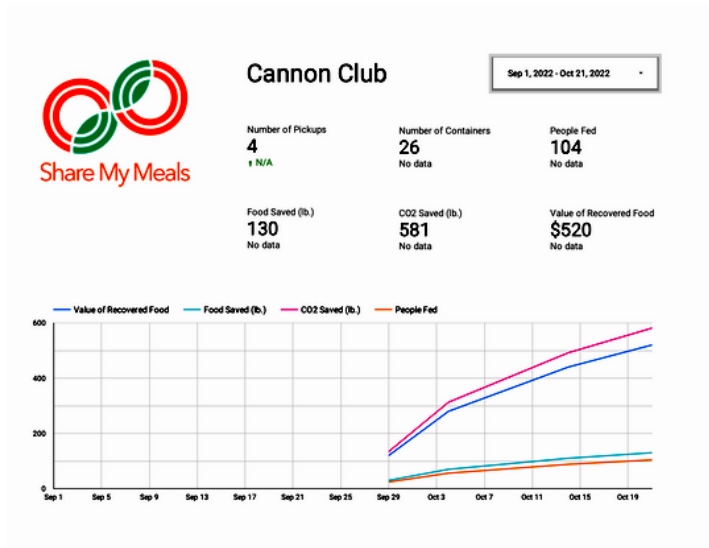
